**HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid**  
This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide an advanced first aid response, including management of the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

The unit applies to workers who may be required to provide, coordinate and manage a first aid response across a range of complex situations, including community and workplace settings.

**HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation**  
This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to use specialised equipment in the provision of resuscitation in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

This unit applies to workers who may be required to use specialised equipment to provide resuscitation in a range of complex situations, include community and workplace settings.


### DURATION

# HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation



## Unit Outline

The units of competency HLTAID006 - Provide advanced first aid and HLTAID007 - Provide advanced resuscitation will be delivered together utilising individual assessment tools.

### Rationale and Time Allocation

The units are provided as a single units of competency HLTAID006 - Provide advanced first aid and HLTAID007 - Provide advanced resuscitation. The course will be delivered as face-to-face as a two (2) day course consisting of 8 hours respectively, which includes theory and practical assessment, to ensure each student is provided the opportunity to fully absorb the required knowledge and to develop the required skills in the different contexts they would experience in the workplace.



### Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this unit, however upon enrolment students are expected to provide photo ID and fully complete the LLN threshold test to ensure they can complete the unit of competency.

### Enrolment Requirements

As this unit requires participants to apply and practice their new skills across an organisation, have access to different occupational groups and circumstances, and to base their assessment solutions in a workplace environment, it is strongly recommended that participants are employed or otherwise engaged in a workplace related role.

A USI is a 10-character string unique to students which is needed anytime students undertake nationally recognised training, such as applying into this program. Students can create a USI following the link on how to create a USI:

### Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

### Delivery Mode and Assessment

The unit of competencies PUAEME001 Provide emergency care HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid & HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation will be delivered as face to face with theory questioning and practical assessment tasks.

Face-to-Face - 1 trainer for 10 students to allow for quality assessment during practical assessment activities, this ratio must be applied. If student numbers exceed 10 on a course a second trainer must be allocated to assist with the practical assessment.

### Licensing and Regulation

Specific licensing /regulatory requirements relating to this competency, including requirements for refresher training should be obtained from the relevant national/state/territory Work Health and Safety Regulatory Authorities. It is recommended by industry councils and legislation that this course is renewed every 3 years and HLTAID001 & HLTAID007 every 12 months to remain up to date with the latest guidelines.
